## COURSE CONTENT

What do you get?

Successful completion of at least 75% (37 correct) on a 50 question multiple choice open book exam will result in certification as a Certified Pool Operator (CPO) issued by the National Swimming Pool Foundation (NSPF) valid for five years. We have a 97% passing rate.

## STATE APPROVED

This course is approved by the Iowa Department of Public Health. In addition, all CPO's are required to earn 10 hours continuing education hours in a 5 year period. These courses are available through IPRA.

## CERTIFICATION

A CPO certification is valid for five years from the date indicated at the bottom of the certificate.

**Full Course** - the student will attend all sessions and take the certification test, but will not be issued a manual. Class times are 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM both days

*Cost \$245 Non-IPRA Member or \$215 IPRA Member/ per person includes lecture, all hand-outs, lunches, breaks.*

**Fusion Course** - NSPF offers an online course which replaces day one of the full course. Successful candidate receives a Record of Completion. To participate at day two, candidate must bring the completion certificate

Course fee \$300 includes 2017 CPO manual, online course password, day two (Wednesday), open book exam, lunch, snacks.

**CPO Manual** - test is based on 2017 copyright edition. Manuals are sold separately and not included with the full course registration fee.
